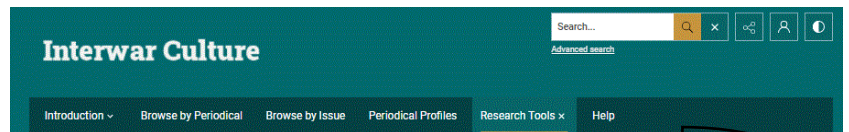

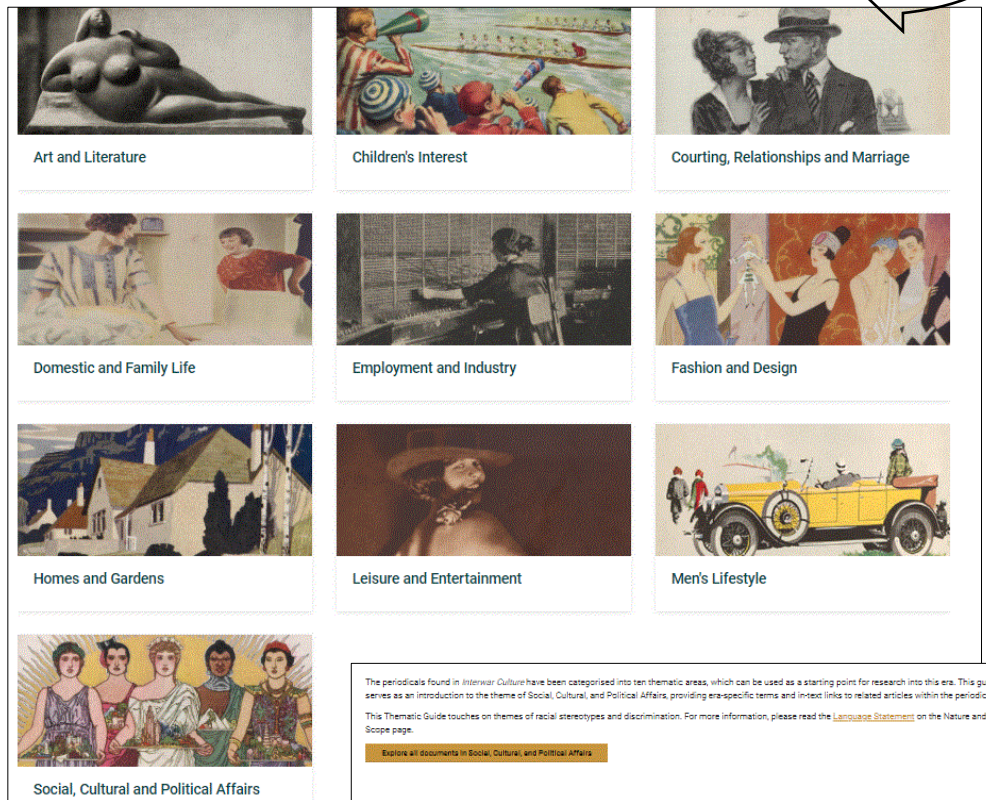

Social, Cultural and Political Affairs

The decade of the 1920s was wrought with change. The end of the First World War and the devastating successive waves of influenza across Europe brought about great disorder on many levels, affecting everything from entertainment and established gender norms to political discourse and technology.

In order to consider the events of this decade, an understanding of the whirlwind of social, cultural and political upheaval is key.

Although British women won the vote in 1918 (American women won theirs in 1919 and French women in 1944), it was not until 1928 that they were able to vote at an age lower than 30, unlike men who could vote from the age of 21. A shortage of men during the war-time years in Europe had created a deficit of workers, meaning that many more women were called to take up places in factory work, as teachers, in department stores, and as clerks. In taking up these jobs, women were able to prove their economic worth within society outside of child rearing and housekeeping. As more and more women found themselves freer than their mothers and grandmothers had been, the young began to experiment by pushing at the boundaries imposed by their dichotomised gender spheres, aided by early waves of feminist thought.

This new generation of young adults, chastised by older generations for their loose morals, were the true pioneers in creating a provocative youth movement (although in Germany in particular, suffering more than most after the war-time years, the Youth Movement took on a very different form). They wore short dresses with more masculine and youthful dropped waists, inspired in part by female tennis legend Suzanne Lenglen whose tennis apparel (designed to enable her to

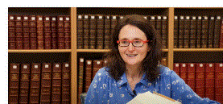
